\$175 deposit due once cast. Payment plans & scholarships are available for those who qualify.

Auditions for students 14 to 19 years old only for this production. Students will be asked to prove their age at their audition and must bring one copy of a document that shows their birth date (e.g. copy of birth certificate, student report card, student ID, or passport). Plan to arrive 30 minutes before the audition time to allow for paperwork and photography. To save time, download the forms from the bottom of this page, fill them out and bring them with you.

*Parents will not be permitted into the audition room; however, parents are needed to sign necessary paperwork for any students under 18 years of age.*

### **AUDITIONS – Commonly asked questions and general information.**

#### **What time should I arrive?**

Please arrive 30 minutes before the audition to fill out any paperwork, show proof of age, have photo taken and relax a few minutes before the audition. There will be a sign-up sheet and auditions will be held in the order of arrival.

### Where is the best place to park?

The Metroplex Parking Garage off of Broadway, 220 Broadway.

### Is there a waiting area for people during the auditions?

Yes.

### What should I bring?

Identification, a current picture and resume (if you have), music and your instrument. All of these items are discussed below.

### What to expect at the audition?

When you arrive, you will be given an application to fill out, or provide a filled-out application that is available online. We will take students in the order they arrive. If you will be arriving late or need to leave by a certain time, please inform Grace Janiszewski by emailing [gjaniszewski@proctors.org](mailto:gjaniszewski@proctors.org).

### What should I prepare for the musician audition?

Students should prepare two 32 bar excerpts - one lyrical, and another upbeat / rhytmical. They can be from the same piece or two different pieces. Be prepared to play any 2-octave scale.

**Percussionists** will be asked to set up a station with multiple instruments and play from prepared excerpt. They should also be prepared to play from a sight-reading excerpt as well. The prepared excerpt will be sent once registered for auditions.

### Can I audition electronically via video?

Digitally recorded auditions are accepted only for prospective students who live or are in school out of the region. You must provide proof that you are out of the region or state for your audition to be accepted. This communication should come through a teacher or guardian. Submissions must contain the above requirements. **Digital audio submissions are due by May 30, 2020**, submit via the webform on [school.proctors.org](http://school.proctors.org).
